Recently they have had very heavy rain which has made the work very difficult and spoiled some of the crops.

At this time of year Summer Camps will be busy giving children the opportunity to have fun and the opportunity to relax and play. For many families children will not have the possibility to go but will spend all their time helping their family in the fields. We help many children attend camp or Summer Clubs. It really is a delight to see these children "just having fun".



There are so many families in need it is difficult to know how best to help. Summer is a time in the villages when food is not so much of a problem, with fruit on the trees and vegetables growing things are easier. In addition, with the hot summer weather they do not need many layers of clothing. In the summer people's needs change, for example, Catea, a mother of two, lives in the

village of Baroncea with her children, - her greatest need at the moment is for some chairs, they have none, nowhere to sit in the house. In the winter their greatest needs are wood for the fire, food and clothing; - Catea's need for chairs, etc., although very much needed would not be a priority in the winter.

Our Summer truck was loaded on Thursday evening 12th July - and received Customs clearance at Dover the following morning. After crossing the continent it arrived in Moldova and was unloaded this past Thursday 19h July. We are grateful to the driver, Zamfir Pascaniuc, for arranging to bring a load to England so that he can take a load of our aid back with him and offload at Beltsy. Zamfir lives in the north of Romania near the border with Moldova.
